

Masks are Now Required in Colorado

Colorado Executive Order D 2020 138, in effect from July 17, 2020, for 30 days

- The order requires the following Guidance for Mask Wearing (while at the CBS)
 - 11 years and older are required to wear a covering over their noses and mouths while entering or moving within
 - Exercising with a group requires a mask
- People who do not have to wear a mask include:
 - Those who are 10 years and younger
 - People who cannot medically tolerate a face covering. Essentially, this means a person that has trouble breathing
 - Outdoors You are not required to wear a mask; you should maintain social distancing.

Due to HIPAA we cannot legally ask you about your medical condition. Therefore, if we see you without a mask, we will assume you have a medical condition and we will welcome you inside.
